New Developments: The KnK Genesis Pro received its final touches and deliveries will start early 2011 for this compact and well-mannered fun-to-drive rental pro kart. The stock Genesis Pro is fitted with two Honda GX200cc engines (not shown).

Features include a powerful hydraulic brake to haul the Genesis Pro down quickly. The hydraulic master cylinder is placed out of harms way ahead of the petrol tank and between the pedals.





The **KnK Genesis Pro** is fitted with a floor mounted 8-litre petrol tank and the red body parts set it apart from the other Genesis models. Engine cowls are an optional fitting.

Adding to the strong 1060mm wheelbase chassis are 10mm kingpins and a 20mm stub axle. Sensible design permits a tall driver to drive comfortably.
