KnK Startkart:

India and its neighboring countries have been contemplating a serious 4 stroke racing championship. A growing list of enquiries from amateur kart racing enthusiasts prompted us to lay down a platform based upon the technical regulation requirements for 4 stroke competition karting. The KnK Startkart is such a kart, built on the same platform of a KnK



Kart that won a Canadian 4 stroke National championship in 2010. Exclusively built for 4 stroke racing, powered by a race prepared Honda GX200 TAG Engine producing around 11 bhp, this highly tunable chassis makes it easy to race and setup for different tracks and conditions.

KnK Ace Kart:

The world is going IAME, the recommended platform for beginners' 2 stroke racing as is being encouraged by the CIK-FIA. The class is expected to be introduced in several countries, new to karting, in the near future. The KnK Ace Kart is a highly tunable professional race chassis that can be raced competitively in every class of 2 stroke racing, including the shifter class.

This chassis is presently not CIK Homologated.



These karts will be available from January 01, 2018. The KnK Genesis SX8 has already been shipped to a leading track in India and has been in use for the past one year at professional tracks in Australia, Sri Lanka and Israel.

These karts have proven to meet the demands for rental and race karting and will be commercially available from January 01, 2018.
